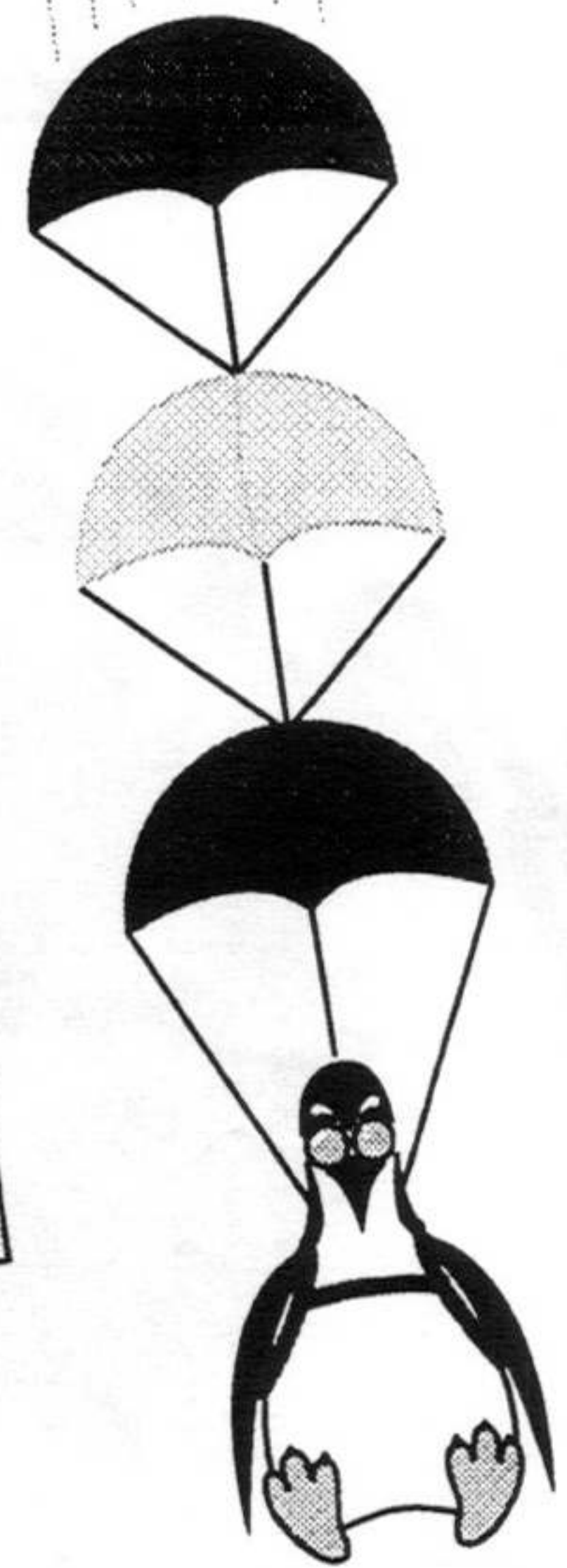

Electrohome and Baton, through TV West (which is headed up by Bruce Cowie), makes application in Vancouver on September 23 for a new television license to serve the Greater Vancouver market. The readiness for such a license can be seen from its phenomenal population growth and the vitality that has spawned. It has just been revealed since the second last B.C. election some eight years ago, the number of eligible votes in this area has risen dramatically.
