

# United Way Update

Many of you have questions regarding the United Way, and how your donation helps. Hopefully this will assist you in making your commitment to support the United Way this year.

## **What is the United Way?**

The United Way is a non-profit organization which brings together financial and human resources. Their focus is to support health and social service programs which are essential to our community. There are 55 member agencies, all depending on community support to maintain their services.

## **Why give to the United Way?**

87 cents of every dollar donated goes directly to help people in need. The United Way is leader in cost-efficient fundraising. They are able to keep their costs low with the support of volunteers and through donated services and supplies.

## **How do I channel my United Way donation to support a specific member agency?**

If you have a specific agency you wish to support with your donation, the United Way office will administer this for you in their office. We are unable to provide this service through the Payroll deduction plan. All payroll deduction donations will be entrusted to the Community Fund, which allows the United Way to determine where their donation will have the greatest impact.

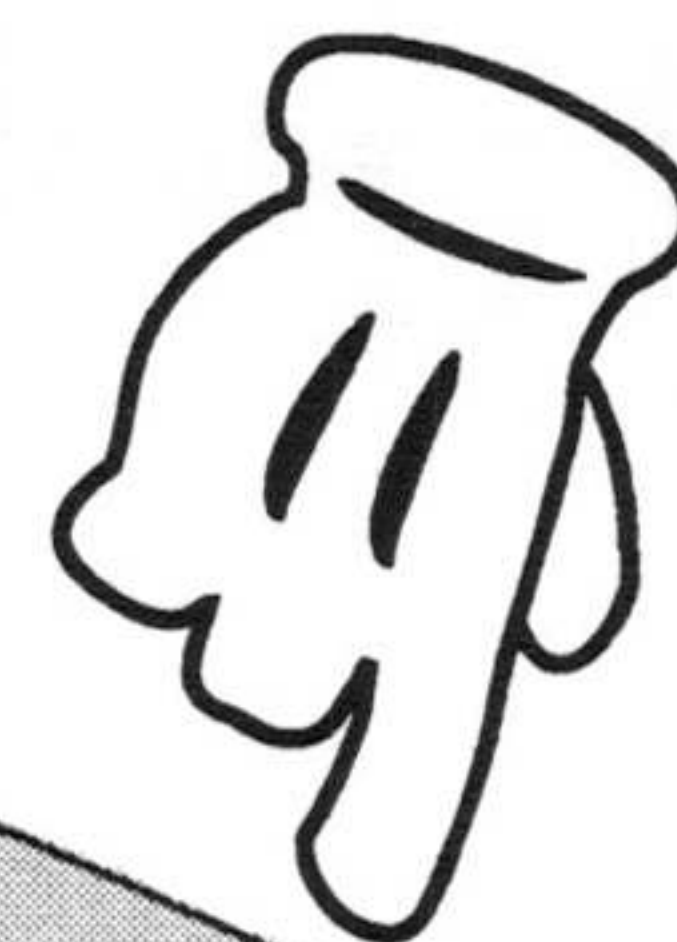
