





AMANDA SINGROY, Videographer


Larry Rose is pleased to announce that Amanda Singroy has been appointed as a Videographer with CKCO News.

FIRST AID KITS IN THE BUILDING

The Health & Safety Committee has conducted a Bi-Annual inspection of the building First Aid kits and supplies have been replenished. As a reminder the kits are located in the following areas:

TOP FLOOR

✓ Sales/Production
Secretary's Desk
- see Cathy Parise

MAIN FLOOR

- ✓ Human Resources
- ✓ Studio 3 beside the door closest to the back entrance of the building

BOTTOM FLOOR

- ✓ Crew Chiefs Office
- First Aid Room located across from the Art Department, the door is clearly marked as the "First Aid Station" which is the main emergency kit for the building. The actual First Aid kit can be found inside the white cabinets against the wall.

BUILDING FIRE EXTINGUISHERS

All building and vehicle Fire extinguishers were inspected and updated in November of 1999. We have replaced all of the White Halon extinguishers with red Halotron extinguishers.

Halon as a chemical agent in no longer being used in extinguishers as it is harmful to the ozone. The Halotron extinguishers have been placed in areas of the building most likely to experience an electrical fire. Halotron can be used on all three classes of fire:

Class A – Combustible (wood, paper)
Class B – Flammable liquid (gas).

Class C - Electrical


The chemical agent "Halotron" contained in some of the red extinguishers minimizes damage to any equipment surrounding the fire area. When using any extinguisher avoid breathing in the fumes/gas for a prolonged period of time as they may cause dizziness or unconsciousness.
