
UNION NEWS




I'll be short and sweet on this one since there is not much to report!

A reminder to all of us...

BOMB THREAT



What to if you get the call.

While the caller is still on the line

- Confirm that the caller means to threaten CTV
 - Ask why they are doing this.
 - 3. Request that they tell you where the bomb is.
 - 4. What does the bomb look like?
 - 5. What time will it explode?

On completion of the call

- Write down as many details as possible (accents, background noise, male/female)
- 2. What was said?
- 3. How was it said?
- Notify a Supervisor, Manager or Human Resources immediately
- 5. If above is not possible call 911 to alert the police
- 6. Do not assume that leaving the building is the safer option
- Stay in your area (you know your surroundings better than anyone) until advice is received.

HELPFUL TIPS

Be aware of what should and should not be in your area or work space. Strange packages, unexpected mail or unattended luggage should be identified every day.

"Suspicious Packages" can be expected to have handwritten or vague addresses. They may smell of oil/almonds/marzipan and they could be taped or tied with string. Sometimes the package could seem heavier than expected or unbalanced. Always be cautious of unexpected packages especially if you are a well known figure, spokesperson or executive






