Dave C's Stress Relief Project Update

75% of the way there with 75% of the work left to do. Major accomplishment with completion of the basic fuselage construction and about 80 per cent of the actual riveting of my RV-7 project complete. It's now time to start installing the "internals" such as the flight controls, instrument, fuel, and electrical systems. I should have that completed by mid March when the finishing kit arrives. That kit includes the engine mount, landing gear, canopy and engine cowlings. The "special build" engine is scheduled for delivery in late May. So if things go well, we're looking at a possible completion by the end of this year.
